







## Emily Sue What Should She Do.2



They worked together and planned and planned.




The lemonade was made by Anna and Kerrie

and Sherry.




So many charities could use a donation.


She could not decide and this led to frustration.

moaned Emily Sue as she lay on her side.


"Sweetie, you need to learn how to choose...

wish....I wish.... I wish.






"A new game, an art set?

And the fairy said, "Two."




"Some ice skates, a new bike or something else fun?

"Please give me a wish." she tearfully pled.


The fairy smiled and nodded her head.



Emily Sue took a deep breath and said, "I find that I want to know how to make up my mind."


Impressed as she was by this lofty request,
The fairy smiled and once again nodded yes.








Making choices had been hard for Emily Sue, but as the seasons changed, her confidence grew.











## After Halloween the good fairy returned. She asked Emily Sue what lesson she learned.
